

## 2019 Firearm Safety Class

Sponsored by MN DNR and the City of North St. Paul Instructors are from the Bald Eagle Sportsmen's Association (BESA) This class is for anyone 11 years old and older on the day of the class.

## Prerequisite:

Prior to this class, the student must complete the online Hunter Course found at www.huntercourse.com. The course has 15 chapters with a 10 question quiz at the end of each chapter and a final exam consisting of 50 questions. The online course fee is \$24.95 and the student will be presented with a voucher after passing the final exam. The voucher is valid for one year. In order to attend the North St. Paul Firearm Safety Class, this Voucher must be presented at the Monday evening classroom session.

If under 18, a parent/guardian is required to be present to sign the Registration and Parental Release form.

**Field Day:** Saturday, April 20, 2019 from 8-10am. *Bald Eagle Sportsmen's Association, 6557 125<sup>th</sup> Street, Hugo, MN, 55038.* 

All books, guides, guns, ammunition, etc. will be furnished by the class. Please do not bring guns or ammunition to this class. Student must be available for both dates, special arrangements and make up dates are not available.

After passing this class, the student is then required to go online to the DNR website and print the formal certificate on their home printer. The DNR cost for this process is \$7.50. **The student is not certified until this process is completed.**
